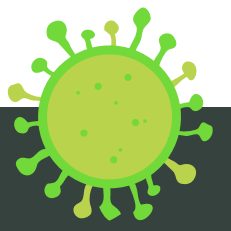


WEDNESDAY 17 JUNE 2020: LIMITED SERVICE DELIVERY IN NON-METRO INFORMAL SETTLEMENTS

While the water situation looks better, toilet cleaning and refuse removal in non-metro informal settlements are still extremely limited. Cederberg, Emalahleni and Msunduzi, for example, do no cleaning of communal toilets at all.

HOTSPOTS

- Many residents in Emalahleni and Emfuleni do not have any access to water and in Msunduzi there is not enough water for all residents.
- No or inadequate refuse removal was reported by residents in Cederberg, Emalahleni, Emfuleni and Msunduzi.
- No residents in any of these municipalities received soap or hand sanitizer.
- Inadequate sanitation ranging from dirty toilets to no municipal provided toilets remains a challenge in Emfuleni, Emalahleni, Witzenberg and Msunduzi.

GOOD NEWS!

- In Witzenberg, one of the Western Cape's hot spots, the light for toilet cleaning improved from red to dark orange because some toilets have been cleaned.
- Three of Mossel Bay's lights remain green, although some residents reported problems with refuse removal.
