

Summary of key results for Emfuleni informal settlements - 30th April, 2021

Access to water

- 50% of residents said there was not enough water in their settlement
- Below are the water-related challenges raised by residents:
 - Water outages
 - Low water pressure

Access to sanitation

- All the residents said that their toilets were not cleaned over the last 7 days
- The following are sanitation challenges raised:
 - There is not enough water in yards to keep flush toilets running, so residents now use self-dug pit toilets
 - Residents use their own means to ensure that they have access to services because they cannot rely on the municipality

Waste removal

- All the residents said waste was not collected from their settlements
- The main challenge is that the municipality does not provide waste removal services in some settlements

DETAILED FINDINGS

Access to Water

The table below shows the water sources that residents rely on in their settlements

| Water source | Percentage of residents |
|---------------------|--------------------------------|
| Water tank | 13% |
| Communal tap | 50% |
| Own Tap | 38% |
| Total | 100.0% |

Residents from Waterdal (Ward 36) said they experienced water outages.

Residents from Evaton - Adam Road (Ward 42) said they have a problem with low water pressure.

Residents from Skikfontein De Deur said there is no water in their settlement, so they fetch it from a neighbouring settlement.

Access to sanitation

The table below shows the types of toilets that residents use in their settlements

| Toilet type | Percentage of residents |
|--------------------|--------------------------------|
| Own Flush | 19% |
| Self-dug pit | 81% |
