What is Day Zero?

Day Zero means that the dams will be empty, and the taps will run dry.



What will happen if we run out of water?

- No reliable clean drinking water.
- No water in schools and hospitals.
- No reliable clean water for cooking.
- Unhygienic living environment (no water for cleaning).

WATER SAVING TIPS



Report water leaks



Use less than 50 litres
of water a day



Use hand sanitiser, not soap



Use a cup for brushing teeth



Re-use water and only flush
when necessary. Only use toilet
paper to minimise sewerage
blockages. Do not throw
foreign objects in the toilet.



Use minimal water in washom.
Re-use water and only wash
what is necessary.



AT COMMUNAL TAPS:
supervise children when
collecting water, no baths,
no laundry, no car wash.
